

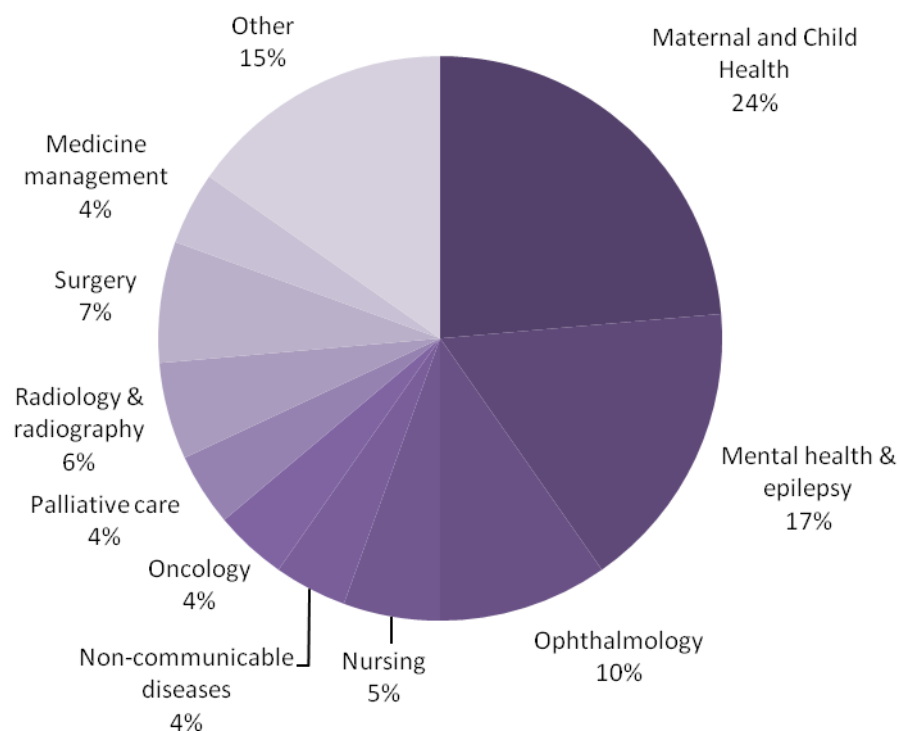
## Facts and figures: March 2011

### Overview

- The final round of grants has now been issued and has resulted in a total of 79 grants being given out of 386 applications, 208 of which were eligible. Therefore 38 % of eligible grants were funded over the course of the scheme.
- The most funded areas of work are for maternal and child health, mental health and ophthalmology
- Unsuccessful applicants from round 2 were offered feedback on their applications and of 53 eligible applications received in round 3, a total of 11 (21%) were resubmissions from rounds 1 and 2.

## Countries

- Uganda has received the largest number of grants to date, followed by Malawi, Zambia and Ghana. We have funded two multi-country projects.
- Countries with the highest proportion of funded grants to eligible applications received were Sierra Leone, Kenya and Ghana. Countries with the lowest proportion of funded grants to eligible applications were Pakistan, Nepal, Bangladesh and Ethiopia.
